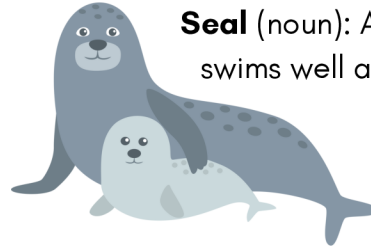


VOCABULARY

Seal (noun): A sea animal that swims well and has flippers.



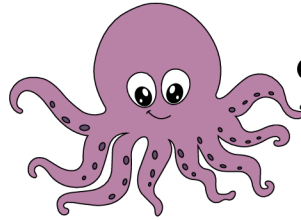
Fisherman (noun): A person who catches fish.

Cultures (noun): Different groups of people with their own stories, food, and ways of life.

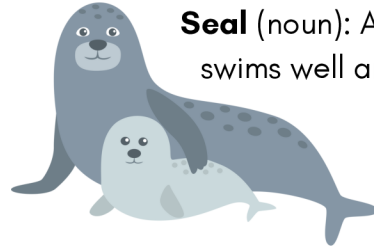


Exciting (adjective): Something that is fun or makes you feel happy and interested.
